## Gather Round ... Ladies

Is an all-age women's group meeting monthly, normally on a Tuesday at Christ Church. It is open to all who want to get to know one another better and to explore issues of mutual interest. Refreshments are provided and a small contribution towards the cost of visiting speakers is welcome (but not compulsory).

Several church members have joined other people to take part in an enjoyable **Chair Supported Yoga** class at St Mark's, run by Yoga instructor Helen.

A lot of the exercises are done sitting down, and although quite a few are standing, it's always with the chair within reach for support! We're of widely ranging abilities, but we just do what we can and when we can't, Helen finds another way for us to achieve the same result. There is not a lot of aerobic exercise and we don't have to get down on the floor, so we don't need special clothes, as long as we can move freely in what we wear.

We've really benefitted from this class: it helps stretch our bodies all over, so eases aches and pains, and that is very helpful for relaxing and sleeping at night. #### Russian Choir Concert at Christ Church

The Resurrection (voskresenije) Choir of Saint Petersburg will be performing at Christ Church on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November.

We have been asked to provide accommodation for 9 people for one night after the concert and provide breakfast. And transport to their next appointment at the airport for their flight home

The Voskresenije Choir, who are all internationally trained at the world class St Petersburg Conservatoire and conducted by musical director by Jurij Maruk, sing a concert programme in two parts. A sample performance is the first half concentrating on Russian sacred music by such composers as Rahmaninov, Chesnokov and Bortniansky, and the second a series of Russian folk songs, which allow in particular each of the performers to provide a solo.

Their conductor, Jurij Maruk, was born in 1961 in Barnaul, West Siberia. In 1976 he began to study music and conducting at the local music facility in Barnaul. After finishing

musical school he was admitted to the Novosibirsk State Conservatory (1980-1985) in Professor Boris Pevsner's class. At this time he worked with the Chamber Choir (Novosibirsk) directed by Pervsner, who was working in close cooperation with the Wladimir Minin Choir in Moscow. Between 1987 and 1989, Jurij Maruk worked at the Mariinsky Theatre (opera and ballet) in St Petersburg as a choir singer. Here he had his initial experience as a conductor and artistic leader of the Mariinsky Theatre (sacred music). Between 1990 and 1992, Maruk worked as the choirmaster of the St Petersburg Radio and Television Choir.

He then founded the vocal ensemble Resurrection -Voskresenije in Russian - in 1993. It consists of seven to ten professional female and male vocalists. They sing A-Capella (without complement.) The repertoire of the ensemble includes Russian Sacred Music as well as folk music. Guest performances in Germany, Switzerland, Norway, Austria, the UK, France and Italy, as well as YouTube and the BBC, have met with great success, and the choir has recorded several CDs of their repertoire, which includes some especially composed arrangements of Burns songs by John McIntosh.
